THE AWARD

The President's Award for Nurses is a national award given in recognition of the outstanding performance and the significant contributions nurses make to the profession and the community. Nurses form the backbone of healthcare services and they play a vital role in caring for the sick and in building a healthy nation. Throughout the years, nurses have embraced the ethos of caring and their dedication and commitment are commendable. The award will be presented by the President of the Republic of Singapore.

The award will be used by the recipient for professional development and personal enrichment. It includes an expense-paid attendance at local and/or international conference, a trophy and a certificate. A maximum of 3 awards will be given.

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE AWARD

Nominees for the award should be trained nurses and midwives who:

- · are in full-time service in hospitals or other institutions
- show outstanding professional competence, resourcefulness, and innovation in the various fields of nursing
- · are role models in upholding personal and professional integrity
- · nurture, challenge and inspire young nurses to achieve their potential
- are committed and dedicated in imparting their professional expertise in community outreach and voluntary service.
