Mrs Mildred Tan was the Managing Director with Ernst & Young Advisory Pte Ltd from 2002 to mid-2018. Her work was in the Business Advisory services focussed on corporate strategy and people advisory. She led large complex transformation projects in workforce enterprises and customer frameworks driving business strategies, innovations and change management in building new work practices including business process reengineering and corporate governance.

Mildred held several leadership appointments with EY. She was the ASEAN Regional leader for EY Advisory from 2009-2012, before relinquishing the role to assume the position of EY ASEAN Regional Government and Public Sector Leader (2013-2016), and concurrently EY Asia-Pacific Government and Public Sector Leader (2015-2018). This role change brought her to work with various government sectors including public/civil service innovations in different sectors such as defence, education, social services, healthcare, manpower, land and infrastructure including e-government and other public services.

Mildred also held other positions, including EY Asean Business Development Leader, and was a member of the EY Asia Pacific Governing Council (APAC) (2012-2017). She retired from the Firm in June 2018.

Mildred is currently Chairperson of the National Volunteer and Philanthropy Centre (NVPC) and Co-Chair for the Council for Board Diversity (CBD) and a Board member of Gardens by the Bay, Community Foundation of Singapore Charity Council among other government affiliated Boards and Councils. She is on the Board of Directors of Wing Tai Holdings and AIA Singapore.

Mildred was conferred Justice of Peace in 2008 and was awarded the PBM (Public Service Medal) in 2007 and BBM (Public Service Star) in 2014 for outstanding community service by the Singapore Government. She was nominated Member of Parliament in Singapore from 2009 to 2011.
