

Chua Thian Poh was born in 1948 and is currently Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Ho Bee Group.

Being actively involved in the community and social services, he serves on the boards of several other companies and community organizations. He is the Chairman of Singapore Chinese Cultural Centre, Board of Trustee of Chinese Development Assistance Council and Ren Ci Hospital. He is the Honorary President of Singapore Federation of Chinese Clan Associations and Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce & Industry. He is also the Immediate Past President of Singapore Hokkien Huay Kuan and Honorary Chairman of Bishan East-Thomson Citizen's Consultative Committee.

He was awarded the Public Service Star (BBM) in 2004 and Distinguished Service Order (Darjah Utama Bakti Cemerlang) in 2014. He was also appointed Justice of the Peace in 2005. He was conferred the 2006 Businessman of the Year in the Singapore Business Awards jointly organized by The Business Times and DHL. He was conferred The President's Award for Philanthropy (Individual) in 2012.

Chua Thian Poh was Non-Resident Ambassador of Singapore to the Republic of Maldives from August 2015 till September 2019. He was also appointed by Prime Minister's Office as the member of Elected Presidency Constitutional Commission in February 2016.
