Mr Gan is vice chairman of the Singapore Business Federation and serves on the board of the Singapore Economic Development Board.

He is a member of the Singapore Ministry of Trade and Industry's International Advisory Panel on Advanced Manufacturing and Engineering, as well as the National University of Singapore Engineering Faculty Advisory Board. He is also an Alternate Member of the Council of Presidential Advisers.

He currently serves on the Emerging Stronger Taskforce to review how Singapore can build new sources of dynamism and stay economically resilient in a post- COVID-19 world. He was the Chairman and Managing Director of ExxonMobil Asia Pacific.
